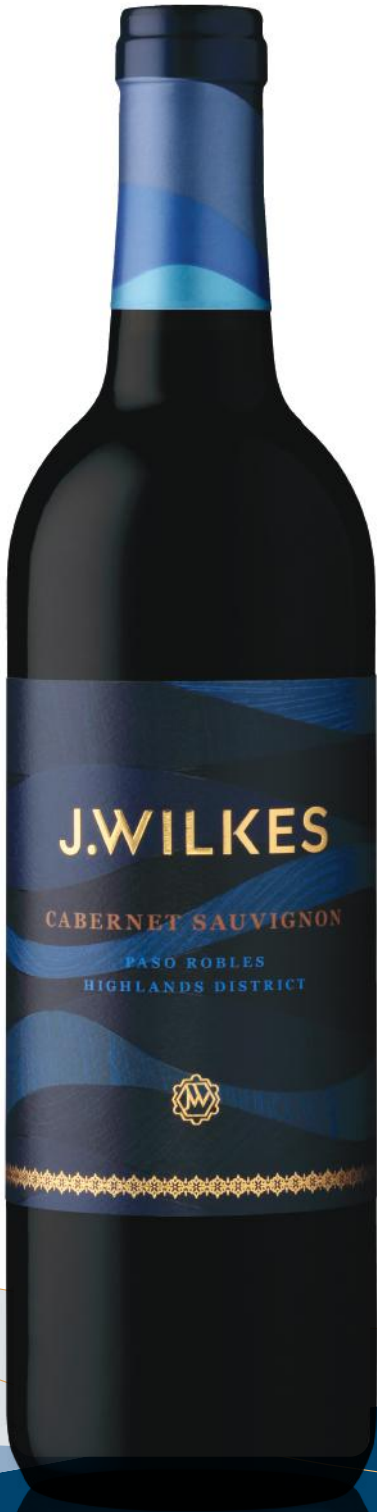

ALCOHOL: 14.5% pH: 3.55 TA: 6.4 g/L

GRAPES

84% Cabernet Sauvignon, 16% Merlot

FERMENTATION

Fermented 14 days on skins in tank

AGING

Aged in 40% new French and American oak barrels for 15 months

AROMATICS

After a few glass swirls, majestic aromas of dark plum, licorice with vanilla get released. Notes of spice and black pepper float from the glass with absolutely stunning fragrances.

PALATE

This Cabernet Sauvignon has dark fruit flavors featuring juicy blackberry, dark cherry, and black currant with chalky tannins. It is rounded out with a smokey undertone and a rich, toasty finish.

FOOD PAIRING

Steak or lamb with portobello mushrooms, or adorn a charcuterie board with Aged Semi-Hard Cheeses like an Aged Cheddar or Gouda.
